Tripedolo extends the artist's series of glass sculptures and originates from the ceramic work Dance. A colorless glass casting on three legs, it unites lightness with balance and recalls the movements of dance—shifting from one leg to another, through space and color.


Presented on a pedestal with optional manual rotation and kaleidoscopic illumination, the sculpture unfolds as a play of refraction and transparency. The form responds to light and viewpoint while remaining rooted in the triangular design language central to the artist's work. Colored light enhances both perception and sculptural expression.
